The following questions can be used as conversation points and to check understanding or to guide discussion:

What does LMI stand for? Labour Market Information

What use do you think LMI is? LMI effectively describes the world of work. Local Labour Market information concentrates on what current and future demand there is in a specific area to support young people in knowing the emerging and available roles that may exist and what skills and qualifications they may need.

What is the population of Hertfordshire? 1,195,700

How many businesses exist in Herts? 62,870

What Industry Sector has the largest amount of businesses? Professional, Scientific and Technical 19.9%, Construction 15%, Information and Communication 11.1%

Why do you think that Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing feature less in Hertfordshire? Hertfordshire doesn't have any coastal towns where fishing can often be one of the main industries and has less rural landscape for cattle and sheep to graze.

173,392 Jobs were advertised between May 2021 and May 2022. Why do you think there were so many? People retiring, new jobs emerging as technology changes, expanding industry sectors – Science (Stevenage GSK, Cell and Gene Therapy), Creative (SKY, Elstree Studios) create new jobs. This means more demand on business, legal and financial services. More people living – NHS jobs required. Demand for goods increases - jobs in logistics and transport.

Looking at the LMI for your District – What are the top Employment Sectors? What jobs will fall into these sectors?

What companies do you know of nearby that could fall into these sectors?

How many of the companies listed do you know of?

What are the benefits of working in Hertfordshire? *Higher average pay than the rest of the country. Less travel, more likely to have better qualifications.*
